INTRODUCTION: NZC 2019 JUNIOR SURVEY

The new 'Age & Stage' (A&S) junior formats were formally introduced to cricket nationwide at the start of the 2018/19 season. The rationale, and supporting evidence, for this initiative has been summarised within the documents prepared for NZC's 2019 Network & Participation Workshop.


NZC's KPI target of 100% implementation within competitions run by associations and/or clubs was achieved by the start of the season.

NZC conducted a national survey in March 2019. Survey invites were sent to all junior coaches registered on Friendly Manager and also to the parents/guardians of all our junior-aged participants registered on CricHQ.

1900 survey responses were received:

- 59% from parent/guardians
- 29% from parents who coached
- 12% from coaches who are not parents or guardians
- 1035 people were from those involved in Year 5 & 6 cricket
- 862 within year 7 & 8 cricket
- 320 answered the 'district cricket'-specific questions as well as the years 5&6 or 7&8 questions.
