

Hi Everyone,

Following the CJCA Spring Tournament and after gaining an indication of those wishing to involved in the New Year 7 Festival 11-14 January 2021 the CJCA has put together 6 teams to participate in this event.

Any parents who are able to assist the named coaches/managers for this event are asked to contact them.

FESTIVAL DETAILS

The format of the event in January will be the following with each team having a blend of days at the Polo Grounds and Mandeville (Ohoka) so players get to gain skills on both artificial and grass pitches over the 4 days – below are the allocations for each team/venue.

The first 2 days will start with Skill Sessions which will be led by a team of Coaches from Christchurch and Canterbury Country with the CJCA Volunteer Coaches aligned with teams able to work in with these additional coaches to provide a solid skill development session each day. On days 1 and 2 lunch will follow the skill sessions and then a 20/20 game will be played in the afternoon. On Days 3 & 4 two 20/20 games will be played with Playoff games of like vs like teams arranged for Round 6 on the afternoon of the 14th of January (Thursday).

UMPIRING

Paid Coaches from the Skill sessions will umpire the games on Days 1 and 2 and Umpires are being arranged for Days 3 and 4 so teams are only to require to umpire at Square Leg if there team is feilding.

The Tournament fee for all teams is \$60


