Elected Director Positions

Christchurch Junior Cricket Association is incorporated for the purpose of governing and promoting amateur cricket for the recreation or entertainment of the general public of the Christchurch region. The capacity of Christchurch Junior Cricket Association to carry on any business or activity, do any act, or enter into any transaction, is restricted to any business, activity, act or transaction carried on, undertaken, done or entered into in accordance with, or in seeking to achieve, this purpose, or which is conducive or incidental to this purpose.

The CJCA is an Incorporated Society governed by a board of volunteer directors who are elected by the members. We have vacancies at the 2026 Annual General Meeting (AGM) to be held on October 27th for the following positions –

- Chairperson
- Secretary
- Treasurer
- Executive committee members (2-4)

A number of the current directors have indicated that they will be seeking nomination again, but this does not prevent others interested from also seeking nomination. The CJCA is looking for directors who bring a willingness and resilience to contribute to and to challenge our current thinking. There are many reasons you might consider this role:

- Our organisation is forward thinking with a clear direction and strategic focus
- Our organisation aims to inspire and support achievement through community cricket
- Our organisation is committed to drive diversity and inclusivity, with cricket a game for all New Zealanders

Skills/Competencies sought

The Executive Committee aims to have directors across a diversity of cultural, gender, technical and generational talent. The focus is on developing a board that models sound governance practices and supports the vision of the CJCA aiming to have “Children choosing and loving the game of cricket”

There are some important requirements expected of all board members:

- Be open to new thinking and respectful of others' views
- Be a team player, while still challenging thinking
- Have business/financial acumen
- Be committed and available
- Add value and diversity to the Board
- Bring cricket and/or sporting knowledge and networks
- Bring an understanding of the community and grass roots sporting landscape

Directors must be prepared to undergo regular governance reviews and be willing to develop their personal governance capabilities by completing programmes such as 'Governance 101 for Cricket' through Sport NZ.

Application Process

All nominations must be made by a current member of the CJCA on the official nomination form. Nominations are due to the General Manager by September 25th by 5pm.

Once received any nominees will have their nomination confirmed with them and it will also be confirmed that they are eligible to hold a position as per our constitution. The confirmed nominations received for all positions will be notified to members at least 15 business days prior to the AGM.

Members will then vote on candidates at the AGM, for any positions where there are more nominations than positions available.
